

VOLLEYBALL CANADA INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER INFORMATION & PROCEDURES

All Canadian athletes, regardless of National Team affiliation or otherwise, must follow the FIVB and Volleyball Canada guidelines for International Transfers in order to play volleyball in foreign leagues in other countries around the world. This includes professional and semi-professional leagues that exist in other regions or zones such as Europe, Asia, South America, USA, and the Caribbean.

Following is the transfer procedure to be followed for Canadian Athletes participating in Foreign Leagues for the 2004-2005 season, along with the Transfer Fee Schedule:

1. Send to the Team Canada Volleyball Centre five copies of the International Transfer Certificate with original signatures and all applicable sections completed in full (see below), along with the required 5 passport photos to:

Applicable Information Please complete in full the top athlete information portion of the certificate, the name of the receiving club and federation, and the transfer period. In addition, for the protection of the athlete the FIVB is also requiring that applicable details of the player's contracts with their clubs be outlined within the 'Conditions' section of the transfer certificate (monthly salary, car or apartment benefits, health coverage, etc.). When sending the certificates, please also include a contact person with the club, mailing address, and phone number.

2. Send the appropriate transfer fee amount by certified cheque, or via the bank wire information below:

3. Immediately after the wire transfer has been made or payment sent, please fax a copy of the wire transfer to our office. Please ensure the name of the athlete corresponding to the transfer is indicated on the form.

4. When the fees are received, we will sign and seal the transfer forms and send them to the club for further processing. Please allow a minimum of two weeks for our processing and delivery of these forms. If requested, a copy of the signed transfer can be faxed to the

club.

Please note: the transfer forms will not be signed and sent prior to the funds being received.

NOTES:

1. For athletes who are playing overseas and receiving no salary or benefits, yet still require international transfer certificates to be completed, a minimum \$100.00 administrative fee will be charged.
